SCQ 50093 is subject to the Union Pacific's Monthly Intermodal Fuel Surcharge, as per the Master Intermodal Transportation Agreement - Item 780. This surcharge is adjusted and announced on a monthly basis via an Intermodal Announcement and posted on Union Pacific's website.

The rates contained in the attached spreadsheet represent the rates that exist in Union Pacific's pricing and rating systems as of May 1, 2014 and is distributed as a convenience for our customers. This electronically distributed document should not however, be considered as an official and binding document should any rate disputes arise.
