



Unit Train is now integrated within Shipment Management

To access Unit Train, select Shipment Management on the Ship dropdown menu.




Using the Navigation Bar

Select Unit Train from the Navigation Bar on the left-hand side.




 You can navigate to Track Shipments, Shipment Management Dashboard, Subscriptions and other customer views (intermodal, manifest, short line).

• By selecting the Unit Train icon, this will expand into available pages such as; inbound, outbound, shuttles (if applicable), train lineup, and forecasting.




Initial Page Load

Inbound View





Train Status Icons




Display of Events: Last Accomplished, Next Scheduled, Last Scheduled, Placement, and Release.





Locomotive Utilization

The locomotive designation is now indicated by the color of the locomotive icon.

Green = Leave Power

Red = Pull Power






Outbound View

- The difference from the inbound view is the order of the columns (which can be rearranged).
- From this view you can: view the trains current status, access the train dropdown menu (Case Management, map, and train inquiry), change/view locomotive designation, track, access consist/alerts, view ETA/events, and release.



Understanding Combo Trains on the Lineup

- We now display the original symbol, combined symbol, and scheduled split symbol.
- The current ACTIVE symbol is blue and bolded.



- In this example, the 150-car train departed origin as the CNAWL 05, was combined to the CBMHW 06, and will split into the CNAWL1 07 until destination.
- You will only have visibility and be able to track the cars that you are the party to the bill on.
