

Unit Trains Explained

Unit trains move large amounts of a single, high-volume product between two points.

One

simple shipping solution:

- commodity
- rail car type
- train
- origin
- destination



One train, three steps:

1 PREPARE

- Empty rail cars delivered to origin facility.
- Product is loaded into rail cars and railroad is notified for pick-up.

2 DEPART

- Locomotive arrives at facility and picks up loaded rail cars.
- Unit train travels across rail network towards destination facility.

3 ARRIVE

- At destination facility, product is unloaded from rail cars.
- Empty unit train departs.




Is unit train service for you?
