Until you know, don't go.

BE AWARE WHEN YOU'RE BEHIND THE WHEEL.

Always be on the lookout for railroad crossings. Once you're aware of the tracks, stay alert. You'd be surprised how quiet and how fast a train travels. Because of its speed and size, a train can't stop in time to avoid hitting you — even if the engineer sees you on the tracks. And when you're crossing the tracks, make sure your landing gear completely clears the tracks so that you don't end up high-centered with nowhere to go.
