


#### **Current Coal Demand Drivers**

- Gas Above Conversion Range

## **Regulatory Impact Still Uncertain**




- Mercury and Air Toxics Standards Implementation Underway

## Stabilizing Domestic Coal Market, But Opportunities Remain for SPRB


- Increasing Capacity

- High Cost Mine Conversions to SPRB


