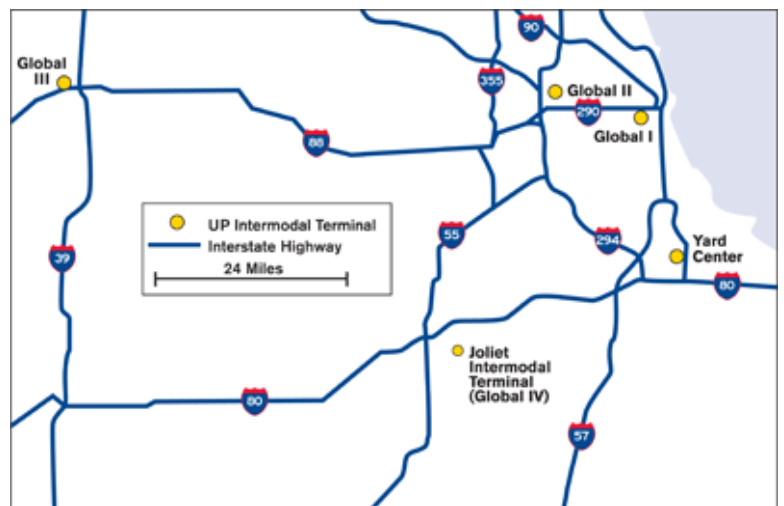

Union Pacific's Global IV: Joliet Intermodal Terminal (JIT) in Joliet, Illinois, serves as a critical hub for international and domestic rail shipments, such as auto parts, canned goods and grain. These commodities travel via multiple modes of transportation in the Chicago region, as well as the developing market southwest of the Chicago.

Located about 50 miles outside downtown Chicago, the \$370 million facility covers 785 acres and is designed to expedite operations and provide expansion capability,

keeping pace with the Joliet area's continued growth. JIT provides necessary transportation capacity for industries looking to locate warehouse and distribution facilities outside of Chicago's capacity-constrained downtown area.



The facility services between two to eight outbound trains and receives between two to seven inbound trains daily, moving up to 3,400 cars. JIT is one of the busiest terminals in the Chicago area and has the capacity to process more than 500,000 intermodal containers annually. The facility's full maintenance and fueling facilities ensure efficient, uninterrupted railroad operations.

Trucks gain access via a high-tech, biometric secured automated gate system, allowing truckers to process a container through the gate in 30-90 seconds, compared to the four minute national average. The 24/7 terminal uses a real-time software to maximize terminal efficiencies and provide customers shipment visibility at all times.

JIT interacts daily with Union Pacific's other Chicago facilities, including Global III and Yard Center. The seamless operations expand Union Pacific's reach across the region, offering quality, safe and cost-effective service, meeting customers' current and future transportation needs.
